

Code of Ethics

Doxa Comunicación, in accordance with the recommendations of major international bodies such as the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE), considers it necessary to promote an ethical publication, and observes the following international recommendations throughout the editorial process:

1. The freedom of expression of authors, who shall not discriminate on ideological, commercial, or any other grounds, against the references and sources of authority used.
2. There shall be no infringement of the principle of respect for human dignity
3. Freedom of decision of the reviewers and the editor. Editorial decisions will always be communicated to the authors with solid reasoning. Information regarding the complaint procedure is available in case of disagreement.
4. The editor's responsibility for preserving the anonymity of authors and reviewers during the review process.
5. The commitment to non-disclosure of data and manuscripts by reviewers and editors.
6. The author's commitment to complying with internationally-accepted guidelines when the research involves humans or animals.
7. Acknowledgement of conflicts of interest, if any.
8. In cases of dispute over authorship, the review process or publication of the text will be suspended until the matter is settled.
